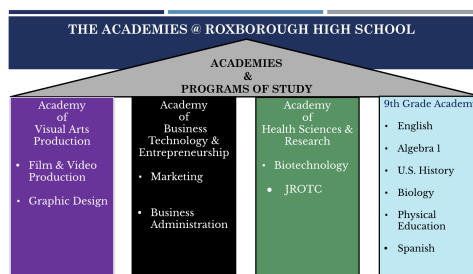

Uniform:

Outermost Top Layer:

- Shirt with sleeves & covers midriff
- Plain navy or grey, or any Roxborough Shirt.

Bottoms:

- At least knee-length
- No holes, tears, or rips



Outermost Top Layer Guidelines



All students will need to wear a shirt with sleeves that covers the midriff.
